

## 2017 YEAR REPORT WITH REGARDS TO THE BURSARY FUND

The Association would firstly like to congratulate Reinier Joubert of the firm Van der Walt & Hugo who successfully completed his studies. Well done Reinier! We wish you the best of luck with your future in the profession!

This year the Bursary Fund started off with seven bursars for the first semester, three of which were awarded bursaries for the first time. Bursaries were awarded according to each applicant's needs and personal circumstances. Their previous results, academic achievements and some other criteria were also taken into account.

A total amount of R58 945.00 was paid towards bursaries for 2017.

Bursaries were awarded to the following candidates and their first semester's results are as follows:

**1. Renette Prinsloo (Van Heerdens Inc).**

No payment was made for Renette's first semester. She registered for two subjects which she failed in 2016 for which she paid herself. She passed both subjects. An amount of R4200.00 was paid towards her second semester.

**2. Pbetsi Thandi Molapo (Friedland Hart Solomon & Nicolson).**

An amount of R5 880.00 was paid towards Thandi's first semester. Thandi only passed one subject. Thandi withdrew her application for a bursary and made arrangements to pay back an amount of R4410.00 with regards to her failed subjects. She is making monthly payments of R500.00 per month.

**3. Reinier Francois Joubert (Van der Walt & Hugo)**

Reinier was awarded an amount of R9 415.00 towards the first semester. He passed all his subjects and completed his studies.

**4. Keneilwe Lefaladi (Gildenhuis Malatji)**

Keneilwe was initially granted a bursary of R10 500.00. When the bursaries were paid out she was no longer employed and therefore no longer qualified for a bursary. No payment was made.

**5. Azaria Malan (Maritz Smith Inc)**

Azaria is a new candidate. An amount of R7 350.00 was paid towards her first semester. Azaria passed all five her subjects, one with a distinction. An amount of R7 140.00 was paid towards her second semester studies.

**6. Celeste Nyland (Stofberg Attorneys)**

Celeste is also a new candidate. An amount of R4 410.00 was paid towards her first semester. Celeste passed all her subjects, one with a distinction. An amount of R5 670.00 was paid towards her second semester.

**7. Suyan Moodley (Gildenhuis Malatji)**

Suyan was a new applicant. An amount of R4 380.00 was paid towards her first semester. She failed one subject and received supplementary exams for the other two subjects. Suyan is no longer employed and is currently in communication with Dawie Beyers' office to make arrangements for monthly repayments of the amount of R4 380.00.

**8. Payments in respect of failed subjects**

Lucille Jennifer Lennox (Rudi Kotze Attorneys) is still making monthly payments towards her failed subjects. She is no longer a bursar.
