



DIRECTIVE BEFORE HONOURABLE JUSTICE NODADA AJ

1. Introductions will take place at 09h30 in chambers 5.12, 5th floor, High Court building.
2. Matters will be heard in open court commencing at 10:00. The Court in which the matters will be heard will appear on the Day Roll.
3. All documents are to be uploaded to Caselines by no later than 16h00, two days preceding the hearing of the matter, i.e.:
 - 3.1 Allowance will be made for matters to be stood down and be heard on the next day (for settlement) or any day between the 07, July 2025 and the 11, July 2025, before 16h00.
4. Failure to comply with this mandatory directive may result in the matter being removed from the roll.
5. Heads of Argument must be uploaded to Caselines under a separate folder (see para 3 above). Heads of argument must be precise, direct and parties should avoid paraphrasing long contents of reports.
6. Where matters have already become defended or settled prior to the hearing, the parties are to inform the Judge's registrar of this fact immediately by e-mail (Lmarota@judiciary.org.za), thereafter, upload a draft order, and bring a hard

copy of the draft order to court should they wish the matter to be removed. This will avoid unnecessary perusal and preparation.

7. The removal and settlement of matters will be heard at the calling of the roll; whereafter matters will be heard in order of seniority.
8. One hard copy of the draft order is to be handed up on the day of hearing. Parties are to ensure that the case details, courtroom, and Acting Judges details are correct on the draft order.
9. The details of a representative from the State Attorney or claims handler (where not defended) and the link number must be contained on the last page of the draft order.
